Request to Exclude Release of Information to Military Recruiters and Institutions of Higher Learning

Beginning in January 2002 with the signing of **No Child Left Behind** legislation, school districts must disclose the names, addresses and telephone numbers of its high school students to military recruiters and institutions of higher learning that make such a request. However, parents may request that the district **NOT** release this information.

Parents, or students who are at least 18 years old, who do not want the above information released to military recruiters or institutions of higher learning must notify the school district by Oct. 1 of the year in which they want the information excluded.
