Topic: Work Permit Issuing Procedure - Summer 2019

All students under age 18 must have a work permit if they wish to work. A Certificate of Physical Fitness is required in order for the student to obtain a work permit. Students must have a valid physical exam on file with the school nurse. If none is on file at school, one will need to be done by the student's private health care provider; the district does not provide physicals for work permits.

## A SCHOOL NURSE WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE BROADWAY ACADEMY NURSES' OFFICE TO REVIEW SCHOOL RECORDS TO SEE IF A CURRENT PHYSICAL IS ON FILE:

- July 1st through July 3rd 9 AM to 1 PM
- July 8<sup>th</sup> through Aug. 16<sup>th</sup> 8 AM to 2 PM
- Aug. 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> 8 AM 11 AM
- Aug. 26<sup>th</sup> through Aug. 29<sup>th</sup> 8 AM 11 AM

## To get a working card (work permit), you will need:

- A completed application, signed by your parent or quardian.
- Proof of age driver's license/learner's permit, birth certificate, passport, etc.
- A <u>current physical</u> the nurse will tell you if you have a physical on file with your school that will qualify as a fitness certification for your working card, when you see her at the times above. (You may call her at 735-3310 or come in person, to ask her to check.)
- If you don't have a current physical on file at school, you will need to see your own
  doctor, nurse practitioner or physician assistant for this; make sure you bring to the summer
  school RN:
  - o a copy of your physical (preferred);
  - o and/or a <u>certificate of physical fitness</u> signed by your healthcare provider

If everything is in order, the nurse will issue your work permit when you meet with her. Broadway Academy Nurses' Office phone: 735-3310
